He spoke about his experiences at St Paul's Shadwell and his work there to revitalise the parish, connecting to the community by meeting them where they are. They were welcomed by the Muslim community who knew they were true Christians by their evangelistic nature. But help is needed with carrying forward the vision

We considered how our churches came about. Some had started in front rooms or scout huts before permanent churches were built. Many here in Ealing Deanery were 'church plants' for new communities

We thought of the numerous projects connecting with local communities in the deanery at present. Examples include Gurnell Grove, Acton Gardens, Messy Church, French congregations and other nationality groups, so many opportunities.

Thinking further of other opportunities to engage with the community – bars, shops, cafes, stations, schools, housing estates, work places

We should aim to support 4 to 5 projects in the deanery, for which we can ask for help
