

Minutes of the Deanery Synod held at Church of the Ascension, Hanger Lane on Wednesday 5 July 2017

Welcome & Prayer Revd Simon Reed welcomed everyone to the parish of the Church of the Ascension with St Mary West Acton. The two were put together in the 1980s. The Ascension, built in 1939, is diverse in every way, multi-racial/ethnic. St Mary's, although built around 1600, was mentioned in the Domesday Book so a church was probably in existence before then. It was a complex process to carry out the £1.2m restoration to St Mary's, which re-opened in 2010. St Mary's is a neighbourhood church, where most people walk to church, whereas half the congregation of the Ascension come from outside the parish.

The evening opened with worship.
