Presentation of Examined Accounts 2017 - 18

Dilys Griffiths, Treasurer, expressed her thanks to Margaret Cobley for assisting her in her first year as Treasurer, and to the parishes for their contributions. She gave a small reminder for those paying through the bank to ensure they put their parish name for reference (please pass this message on to parish Treasurers). Dilys gave a summary of the accounts and answered some questions that had been raised. £249 had been spent on sound equipment for the Visitation. There had been a bounced cheque due to an error in the mission grants process.

There were no further questions. Revd Chris Fox proposed we adopt the accounts, seconded by John Martin, all agreed
